The northern parcel of land is located to the south and east of the operational Llandinam Wind Farm, situated on the Waun Ddubarthog ridge which runs north – south at a height of approximately 520m above ordnance datum.

Garn Fach forestry area is located to the south of the northern parcel. The central parcel of land is located to the south of Garn Fach.

The southern parcel consists of a small area of open upland moorland at the southern end of the Brondre Fawr ridge, separated from the middle parcel by forestry.
